Are we hiding or are we hidden? Lesbians in Hungarian media Roundtable discussion 14.00 Kamaraterem

In Hungary we barely hear about girls and women who are attracted to their own gender. There are no stories, the topic is missing from printed media, except for PR articles that are produced in order to draw attention to a celebrity. (Sonia Nkuya was dating a girl once when she was a teenager etc.). What is the reason for this? Is it the readers who are not curious or do the participants want to stay closeted and refuse interviews? How is it possible to change this situation; does it have to be changed at all?

Let's talk about what it is to be a woman, to be feminine. Do we need gender roles and why? Are there any lesbian criteria for femininity or do we measure ourselves on a heterosexual scale? Where are the boundaries - and do we need any - between men and women, hetero- and homosexuals, butches and transgendered persons? Why are we so concerned with this topic? Masculine woman or transsexual man? Where are the boundaries? Transsexual journey from recognition to integrity. What kind of opportunities do trans men have in Hungary? Where is the boundary between lesbians and trans men? There is a long journey from the recognition through everyday life challenges to self-acceptance and to finally becoming a real man. We will talk about these matters at a relaxed, open, workshop.
